#### 6 UPDATE BY DOUG CHALK

Doug Chalk spoke about the contract negotiations which have been ongoing since March 1997. Exchanges have been made by both sides, and further meetings have been scheduled. Retroactivity will have to be negotiated. Treasury Board can use any classification system they want, but rate of pay will have to be negotiated. It appears that the deficit is being reduced and that money that was saved from Employment Insurance could be used for any salary increases, but negotiations will be difficult. The Work Force Adjustment and no reductions in salary were the result of the previous members' strike. Canada has had many complaints filed at the International Labour Organization and has broken many of its own laws. Union members will be asked to vote on any tentative agreement reached in the negotiations.
